Some Information is from the Army War College.

MG Donald J. Brown passed away 13 April 2017. He was born 24 January 1923 in Milwaukee, WI.

MG Brown attended the University of Wisconsin, Madison in 1942 – 1943 studying Agriculture. His education was interrupted by service in World War II. He earned the Combat Infantry Badge, the Expert Infantry Badge and the Parachute badge. After the war, he received a B.S. degree in Physical Education from Lacrosse State College in 1949. He received an M.A. degree in Education Administration from the University of Colorado in 1955. He was a graduate of the U. S. Army Command and General Staff College and the Army War College.

In 1949, he joined the 84th Division as a Platoon Leader in Company D, 334th Regiment in Milwaukee. He advanced through ranks serving as Division ACofS, G-3, Division Chief of Staff, and finally Division Commander, retiring in 1980.

In civilian life MG Brown served for many years as Business Manager for the City of South Milwaukee School District.
