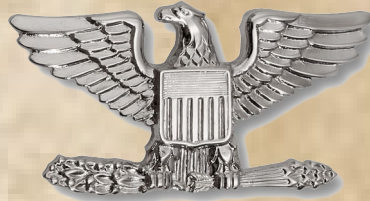

Louis K. Fuller passed away on Wednesday, April 24, 2013, at the age of 82. Beloved husband of 61 years of Marjorie M. (nee Magnuson) Fuller. He was a graduate of Marquette University with a Bachelor of Arts degree.
