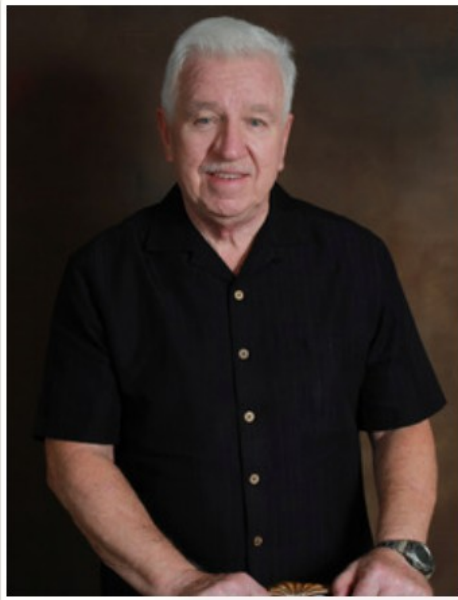




Railsplitter Obituary
