Sandra J. Jenkins passed away Thursday January 5th, 2017 at West Allis Memorial Hospital, after a battle with lung disease complicated by Post-Polio Syndrome.

Sandi is a retired Veteran of the US Army achieving the rank of SFC. The majority of her 25 years of military service was with the 84th Div. U.S. Army Reserve with several years of active service as a Recruiter. During her career and well into retirement, Sandi was active in military and veterans organizations including past President of AUSA, Secretary of the Milwaukee County Veterans' Board of Directors and Secretary-Treasurer of the Milwaukee Metro NCO Council. In her spare time, she served on the City of Milwaukee Veterans' Day and Memorial Day Parade committees, and marched in many events with the Milwaukee NCO Council's five service color guard.
